- All programs are closed for 1 to 1 1/2 weeks at Christmas, 1 week during April vacation, and 1 to 1 1/2 weeks in late August and one FLCP Staff In-Service training day.

Financial Assistance:

- Limited financial assistance is available. We accept payments from the ASPIRE and Child Care Subsidy (CCSP) programs through the Dept. of Health & Human Services. **We have a cap on the number of slots available for state funding.**
- Sibling discounts of 15% are also available if a sibling is attending one of our other programs. The discount applies to the lower tuition.
